1:34 PM – Commissioner Shepherd Macklin called the meeting to order.

1:35 PM – Jessika Shipley, Independent Redistricting Commissions Staff, discussed the first stages of scheduling the public hearings.

1:42 PM – The committee discussed the introductory video and pre-hearing packet as being possible roles for the communications firm. The video would be a basic presentation of the information the commissions want to convey to the public.

1:51 PM – The committee discussed that the pre-hearing packets would be a combination of public comments regarding the area and information about the area.

1:53 PM – The committee discussed issues to address with the joint meeting with the public comment and outreach subcommittee of the legislative commission, including a change in one meeting location, commissioner in-person attendance, the ability to take written comments, and not providing child care.

2:05 PM – The committee discussed the level of detail that should be included in the public mapping solution. Ms. Shipley discussed the plan for the presentation of the maps at the public hearings.

2:11 PM – The committee discussed political competitiveness and whether there are specific questions they should ask their guest speakers next week. The committee discussed the type of information they should solicit from people who testify at the public hearings.

2:23 PM – The committee discussed that the commission needs to determine how they are going to interpret the constitutional language regarding political competitiveness.

2:30 PM – Commissioner Shepherd Macklin discussed framing the public hearings and providing advertising or outreach for the hearings, including different ways that they can reach organizations in their communities.

2:40 PM – The committee discussed the schedule for each meeting including an opening presentation, presentation of the maps, public comment, and commission debrief sessions at the end. The committee discussed a time limit for public testimony.

2:55 PM – The committee continued to discuss a time limit for testimony and limiting the commissioners' time to talk before they limit the public testimony.
