3:03 PM – Commissioner Schepper called the meeting to order. Julia Jackson, Colorado Independent Redistricting Commissions Staff, recapped the committee’s previous meeting.

3:07 PM – The subcommittee agreed to have staff send talking point slides to the full commission for their use.

3:08 PM – The subcommittee discussed setting up a process for reviewing comments. They suggested that they not only classify comments by region but also review them for certain topics. Commissioner Schepper agreed to make a first effort at categorizing them.

3:16 PM – The subcommittee discussed ways to present received comments to the other commissioners.

3:18 PM – The subcommittee discussed recommendations for taking public comment during the commission’s regular meetings. The commissioners suggested setting a time period for public comment, possibly fifteen or twenty minutes total, and three minutes per speaker, plus a requirement to sign up in advance. They discussed offering a public comment period at every meeting or every other meeting.

3:28 PM – Ms. Jackson agreed to provide the subcommittee with the General Assembly’s policies regarding public testimony. Commissioner Schepper also reminded the subcommittee of her goal of having a communications policy for the commission and agreed to send around a draft policy.

3:32 PM – The subcommittee discussed progress on hiring a communications consultant and on keeping open communications with the General Assembly. They considered providing weekly reports to various constituencies, including legislators and election officials.
